



Hello, at The Children's Court Guardian Agency we want to tell you about how we use the things we find out about you when you talk to a Guardian.

A Guardian is a social worker who visits children and young people. A Guardian's job is to keep you safe.

A judge asks the Guardian to visit a child or young person. The judge wants to know all about you.

A solicitor works with the Guardian and speaks for you to the judge.

Judges work in Family Courts. The Judge has been asked to decide what is best for you.

We will find out things about you such as your age, where you live, who lives with you and we will talk to your teacher.

We will share these things with the Judge and Solicitor.

We do all this because the judge has asked us to do this. We keep the things you told us about safe and make sure that only those people allowed can see it.
